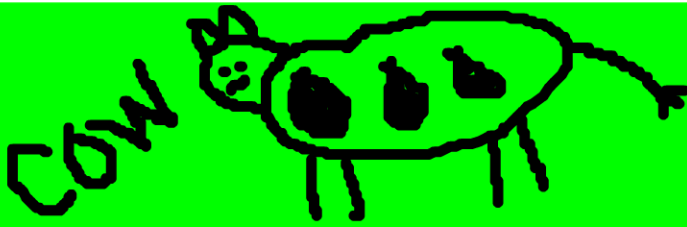


# Mammals

Examples: Pandas, Tigers, Cows, and many more.



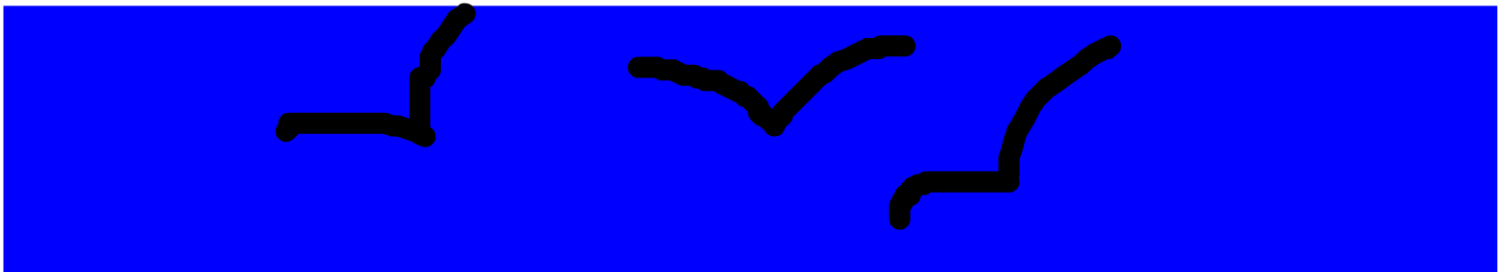

# Reptiles and Amphibians

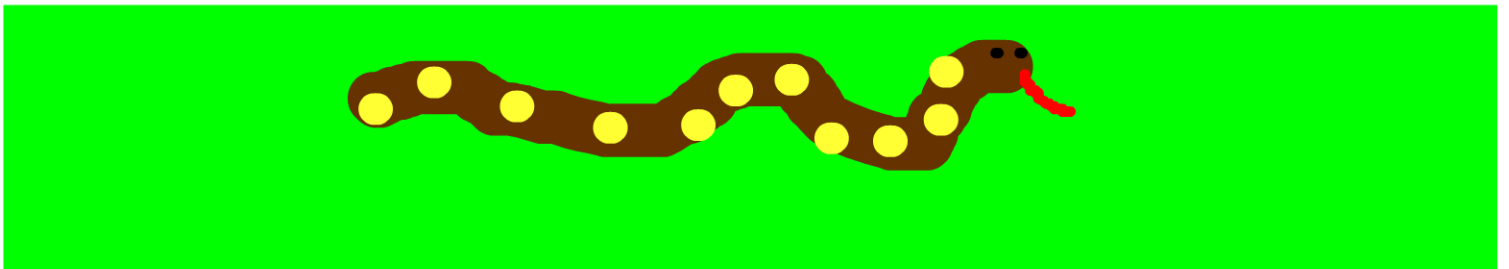
Reptiles have scaly, dry skin.

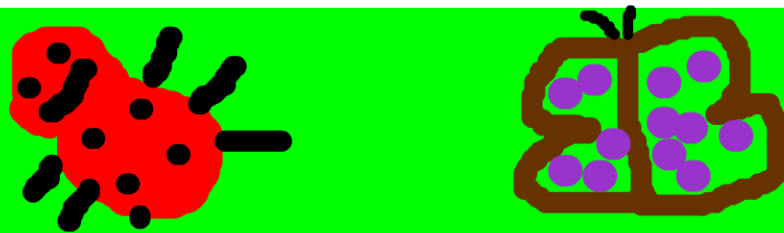
